Eight (8) scholarships, with a value of \$2,600.00 each, and available for use at any accredited college or university in the United States or Canada will be awarded by the USW District 1-Sub District 1 Welfare and Scholarship Fund from April 15, 2023 through May 31, 2024.

Who is eligible? Any member of a participating local of the United Steelworkers, District 1 - Sub District 1 Welfare and Scholarship Fund, in good standing, who has not previously attended any college, whatsoever, and who would be able to enter a college as a freshman student, and any member of a high school class graduating between January 1 and July 1 of the year the award is to be made, **whose 3.2 grade point average or higher** is certified by the high school principal and who is either a member, the son or daughter of a member or the legal ward of a member of any participating local in the USW District 1 - Sub District 1 Welfare and Scholarship Fund, is eligible to compete.

How to apply: Applicants will fill out the attached application blank, giving all required information. Incomplete information will be the cause for rejection of the application. They will then have their academic status and **GRADE POINT AVERAGE** certified on the reverse side of the application blank by the principal of the high school attended. They will also have their relationship to the United Steelworkers certified by a responsible official of the local union of which the applicant, applicant's parent or applicant's guardian is a member.

The form should then be mailed to the United Steelworkers, District 1 - Sub District 1 Welfare and Scholarship Fund, 25111 Miles Road, Suite H, Warrensville Heights, Ohio 44128.

CLOSING DATE: To be considered, applications, with all pertinent information attached must be postmarked not later than midnight, May 31, 2024.



Rules of Competition and Conditions of the Scholarship Award

Eight (8) Scholarships Awards, with a total value of \$2,600.00 each shall be awarded to the participants who must have a 3.2 grade point average or higher. The eight scholarships will be awarded to the participants with the highest grade point averages. Should there be remaining scholarships with participants with a grade point average of 3.2 then the remaining scholarships will be awarded by a blind draw.

Individuals who are awarded Scholarships will have arrangements made for payment of their tuition, after they present evidence that they have been accepted as a freshman student in an institution accredited by a regional association of colleges or by a State Department of Education. Checks, for tuition only, will be issued upon request by the student beginning his freshman year and quarterly or by semester thereafter upon receipt of transcript of grades. The award will be invalid and no payments made to an individual who fails to register in an approved college prior to the first day of December of the year in which the award is made, except that, in the case of winner who shall enter the Armed Services during the above period of limitations. The limitations shall be six months after the date of discharge from the Armed Services, or six years from the date of the award, whichever date shall occur first. Six hundred fifty dollars (\$650.00) will be paid on a pro rata basis toward tuition, to the accredited college or university of the student's choice for each academic year, for a maximum of four years totaling (\$2,600.00). An adjustment in the schedule of payments will be made in the case of an individual following an accelerated program which will result in a Bachelor's Degree in less than the normal four years. A Scholarship recipient will be limited to a total of seven (7) years in which to complete the four year undergraduate study leading to a Bachelor's Degree.

If it becomes necessary for Scholarship Winners to interrupt their education and they intend to continue at a future date, they shall request a leave of absence by written application to the District 1 - Sub District 1 Welfare and Scholarship Fund Board of Trustees stating the reasons for such leave. Should the reasons stated in the application be acceptable to the Board, they may grant a leave of absence not to exceed two years.

Any student who participates in any anti-government, anti-labor, or anti-draft demonstration will be disqualified from a scholarship from the United Steelworkers, District 1 - Sub District 1 Welfare and Scholarship Fund.

Payments will continue to be made so long as a student maintains an academic status acceptable to the college or university and maintains a full time status as a student. There are no restrictions as to the curriculum a student may follow, except that it be one that will normally lead to a recognized Bachelor's Degree.

All matters pertaining the Scholarship Awards will be decided by the Board of Trustees of the United Steelworkers, District 1 - Sub District 1 Welfare and Scholarship Committee, whose decision shall be final.
